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A. Course Description

Overcomers Ministry is a stimulating, inspiring and innovative course that combines God's instruction for His people to remain steadfast through trials by following God direction thru the end. The class will encourage others through Testimonial presentations of His goodness. The Scriptures admonishes us that every believer is called to be an overcomer. "Everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. Who is He that overcomes the world? Jesus is the Son of God (1 John 5:4-5).

If you are dealing with an illness, or critical deadly medical problem, a survival or victim of a trauma, or dealing with grief or depression, or called to be a care for any of the situation listed, this course may be what you need on this life's journey. God has a plan for you to be victorious over your illnesses, diseases, trauma, and limitations. God wants you to equip yourself to be an overcomer by studying His word, and believing that God is whom He says He is. "There is no failure in God."

B. Course Organization

This is a lecture-interactive course in which a different topic will be presented each night. During the lecture, participants will be allowed to ask questions and make comments. A Power-Point presentation and lecture-format will be utilized. Also, each night individuals that have overcome will give personal testimonial presentations of their experience of a tough time in their lives and how God walk them through the journey. The goal is to help the person realize that they are not alone and that God has a plan for their life (and how to help others.) "For I know the plans I have for you,

declaring the Lord, plans to prosper you, plans to give you hope and a future" (Jeremiah 29:11 NIV)

- 1. understand we need to apply God's Word to our lives in all situations, and to stand on His promises,
- 2. understand the importance of having a committed heart to God,
- 3. recognize that it is not by our power that we wage Spiritual warfare, but that it is the Spirit of God that we walk in authority with signs and wonders following,
- 4. Identify factors which keep them from living a victorious life.
- 5. identify Christian behaviors that exemplify God's presence in their lives
- 6. understand there is power in acknowledging that God's Word is the Truth for overcoming any evil spirit or habit when holding the truth in unrighteousness.
- 7. (Identify spiritual guidance to help others to become overcomers.
- 8. Understand how the church can work with professionals to help others to become overcomers.)
